Flexible Training Opportunities (FTO) Funding – KT has checked that there will be sufficient funds and that FTO will continue. There could be a risk that there will be a gap at the end of the financial year in the beginning of 2014. FW confirmed that FTO could not be matched by HIE.

If Moray College buy all material in bulk this can reduce costs in the training being advertised.

Through the network of providers, all must be given the opportunity to work in Moray, with seven being required for the pilot.

There is the potential for all Senior Pupils in Moray – approximately 1300 students – to go through World Host training.

One student to be included in each pilot, one from each school, building on employability and entrepreneurship links.

Pilot courses to be run in February/March, organisation of which will need to be shared by partners. Potential for formal launch alongside Moray Chamber of Commerce Tourism launch in March.

There are 5000 online World Host taster places available, link to be circulated.
