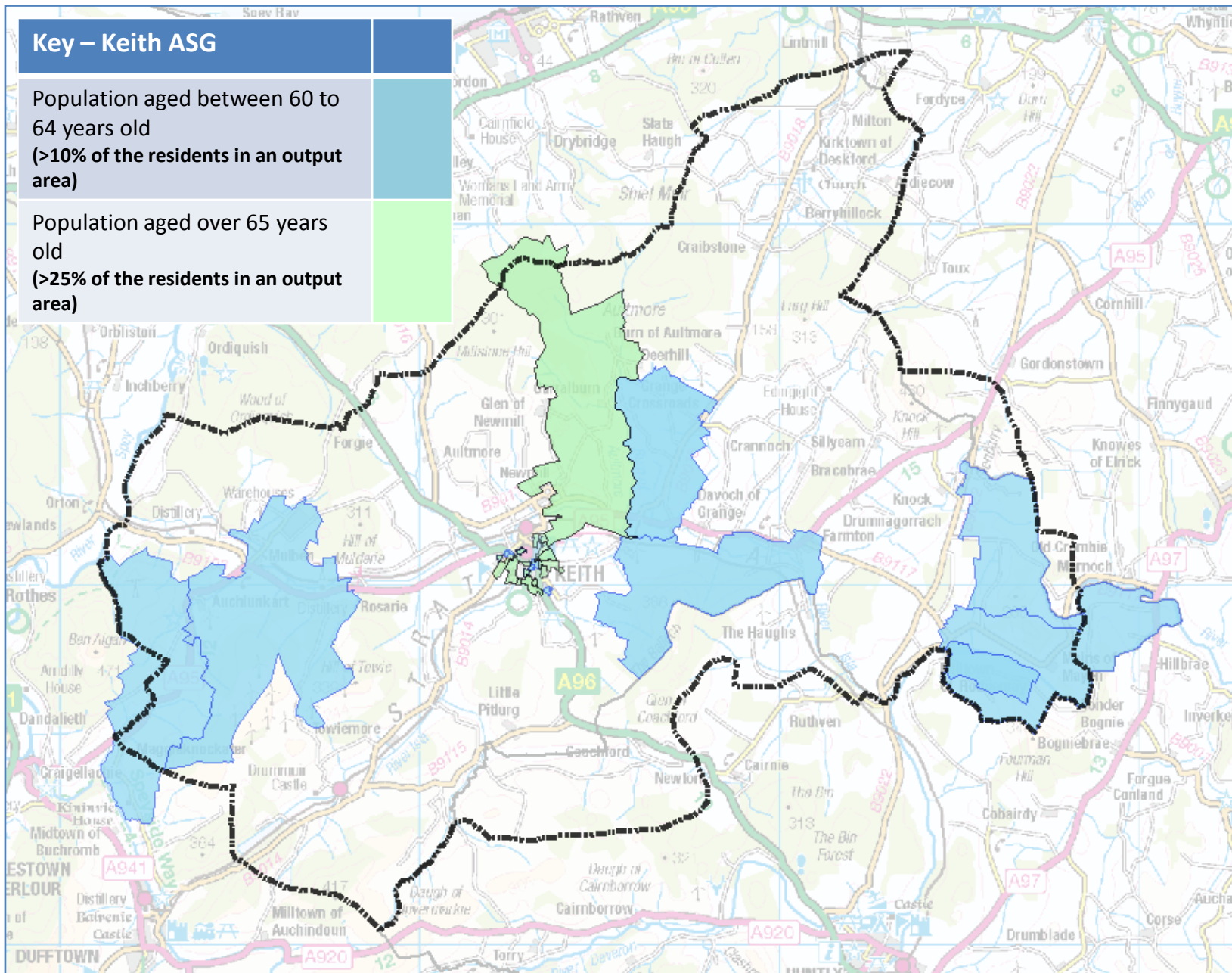
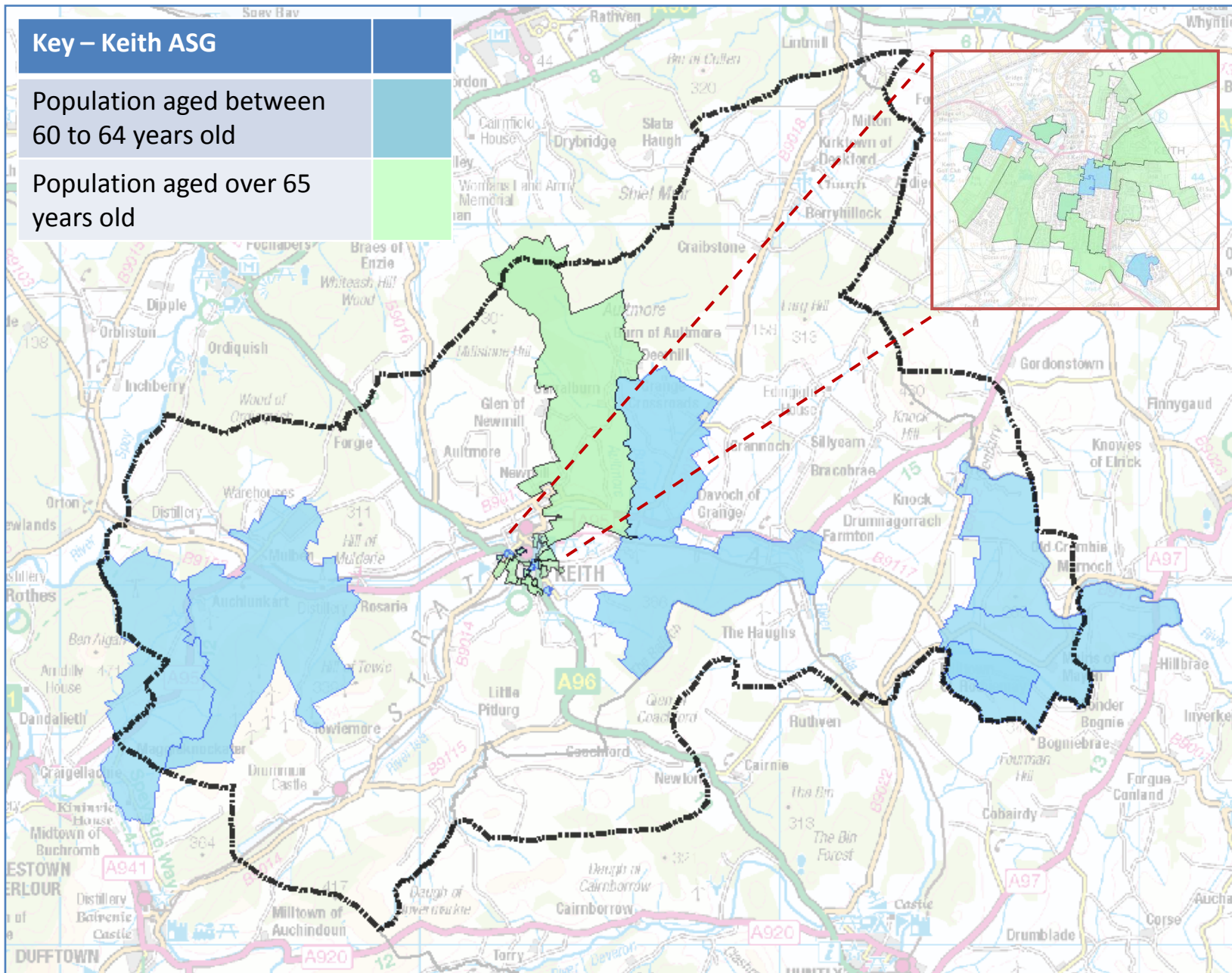


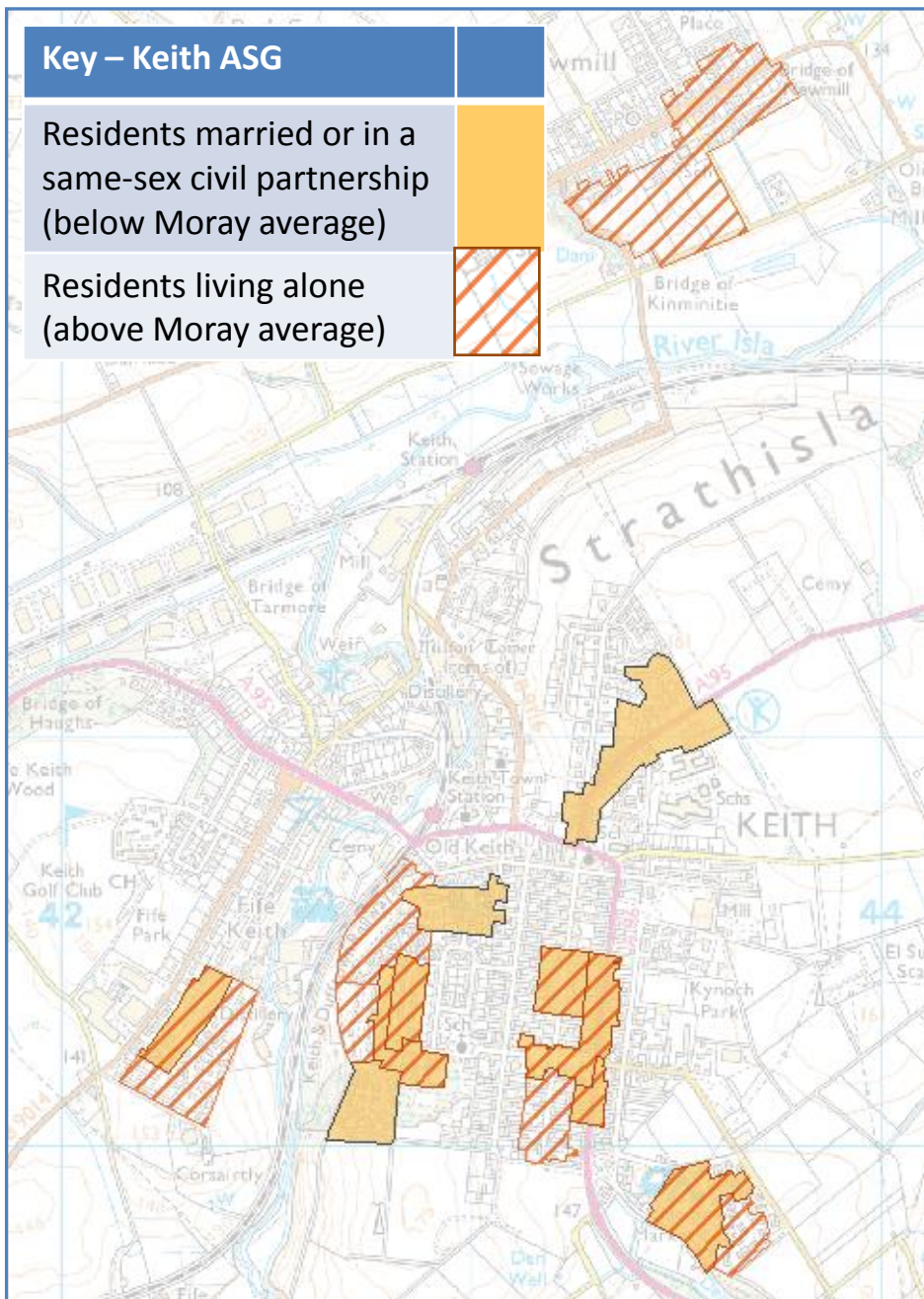

KEITH – POPULATION AGE

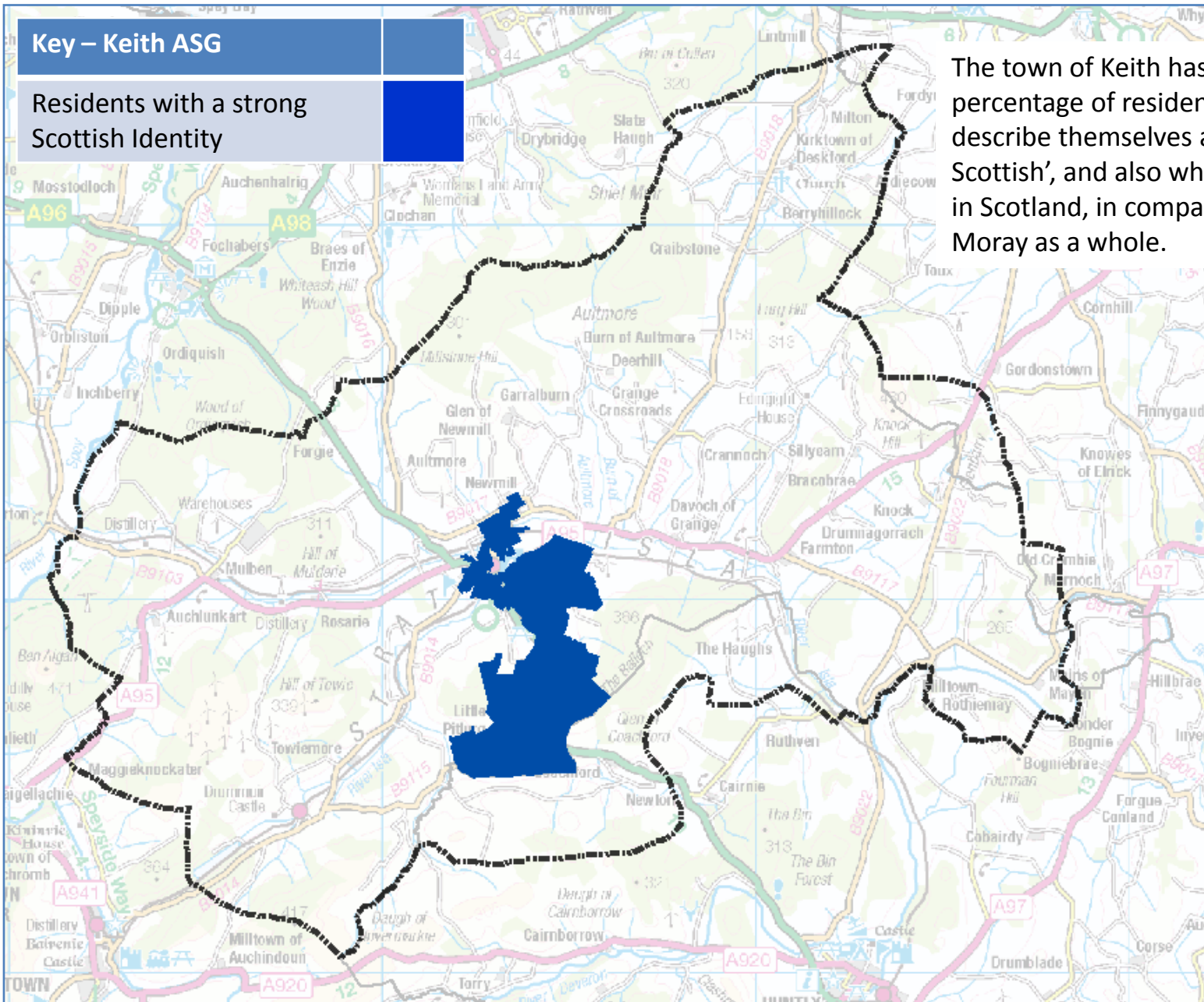


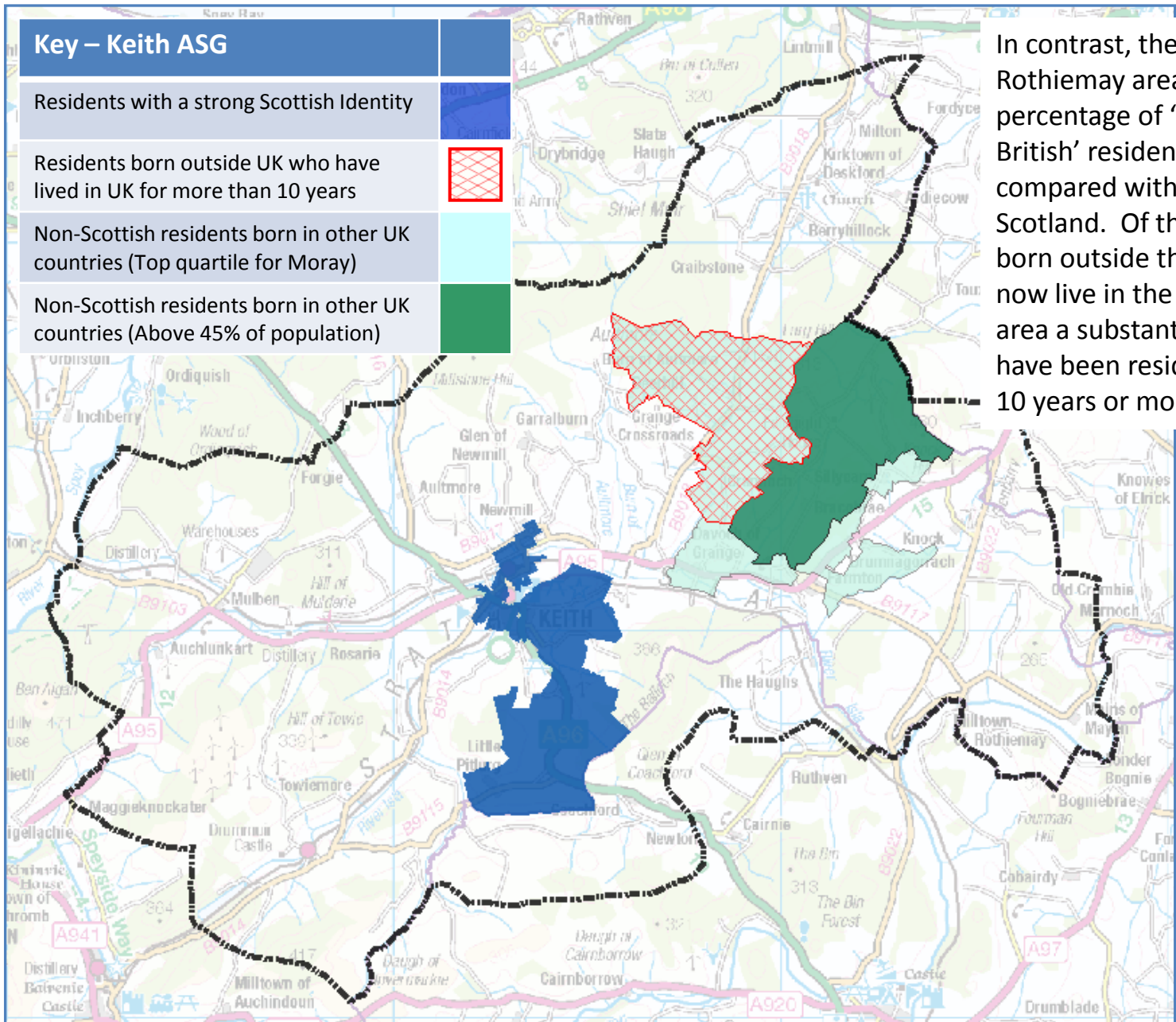

Non-Scottish residents born in other UK countries (Above 45% of population)



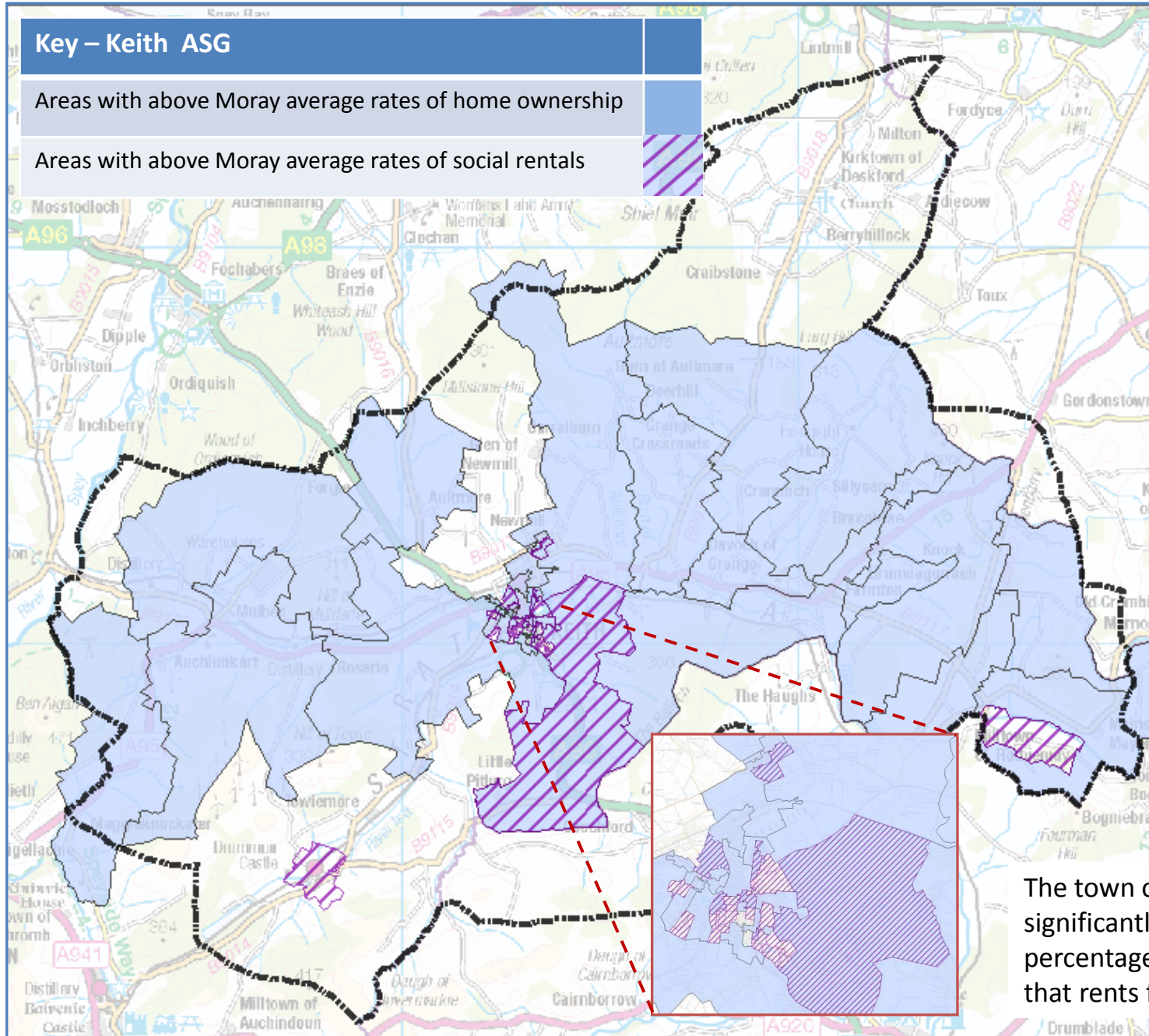
In contrast, the Grange and Rothiemay area has a higher percentage of ‘White – Other British’ residents when compared with both Moray and Scotland. Of those residents born outside the UK and who now live in the wider Keith ASG area a substantial proportion have been resident in the UK for 10 years or more.

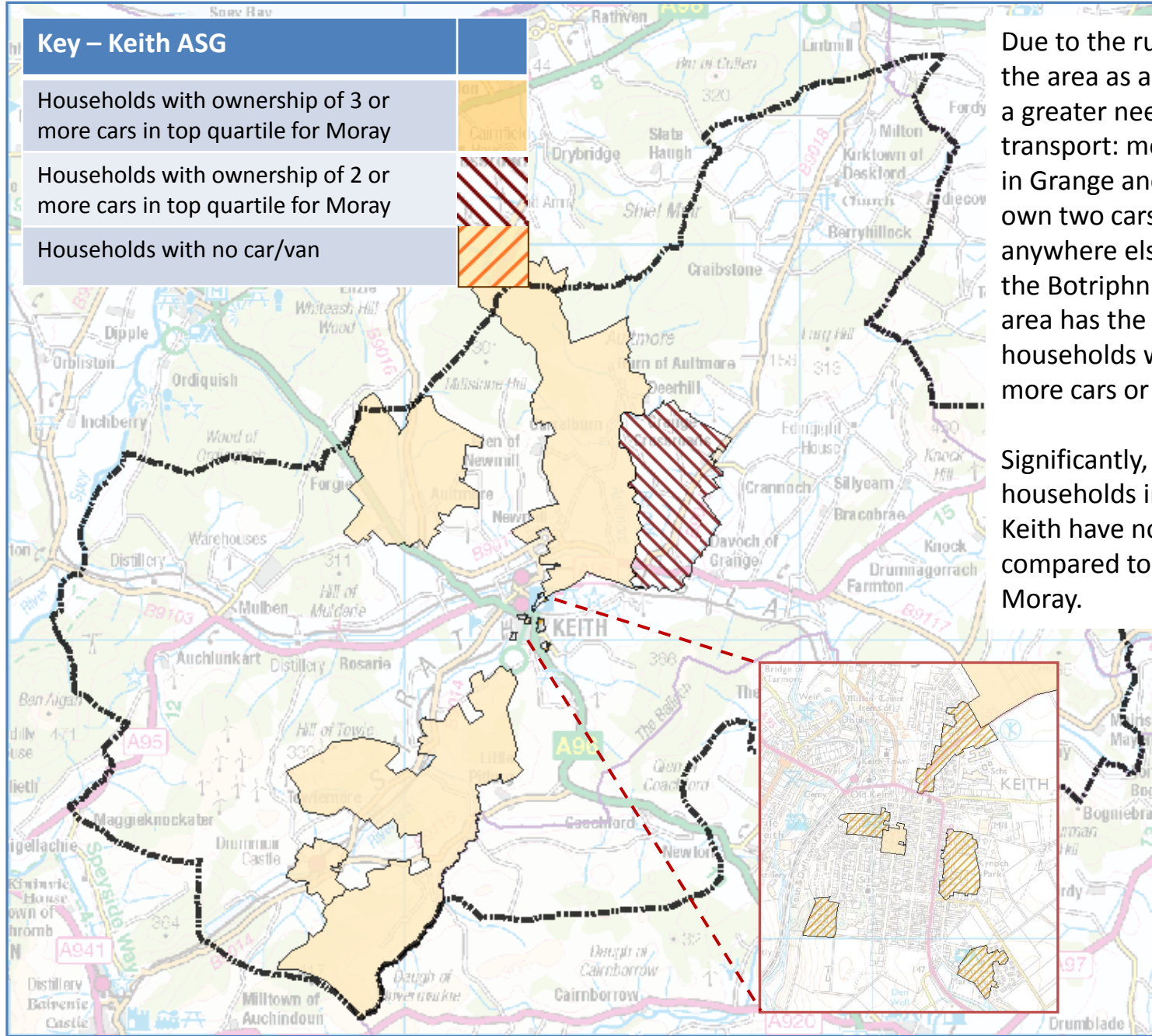

Areas with above Moray average rates of social rentals



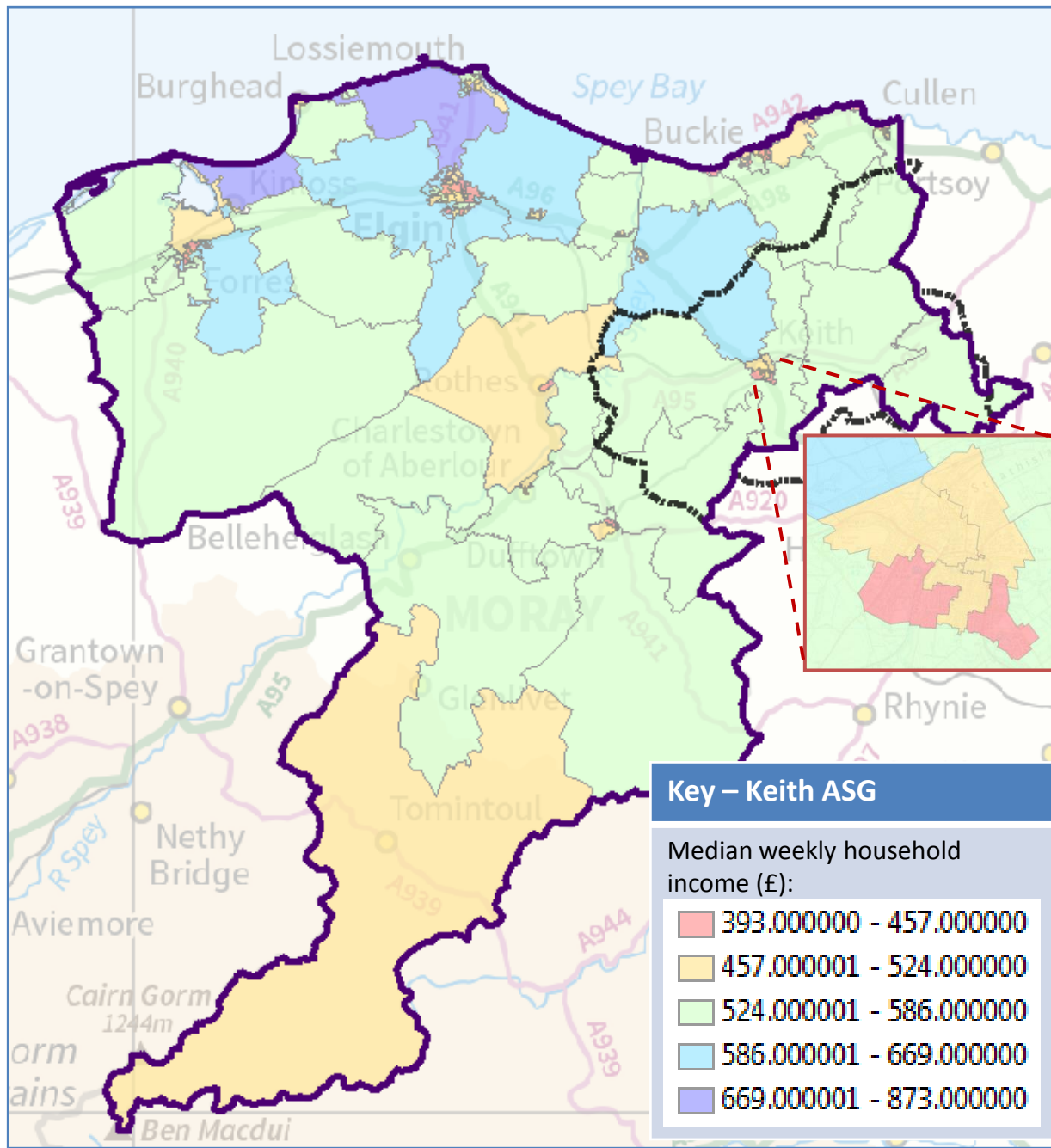
The town of Keith has a significantly higher percentage of the population that rents from the council

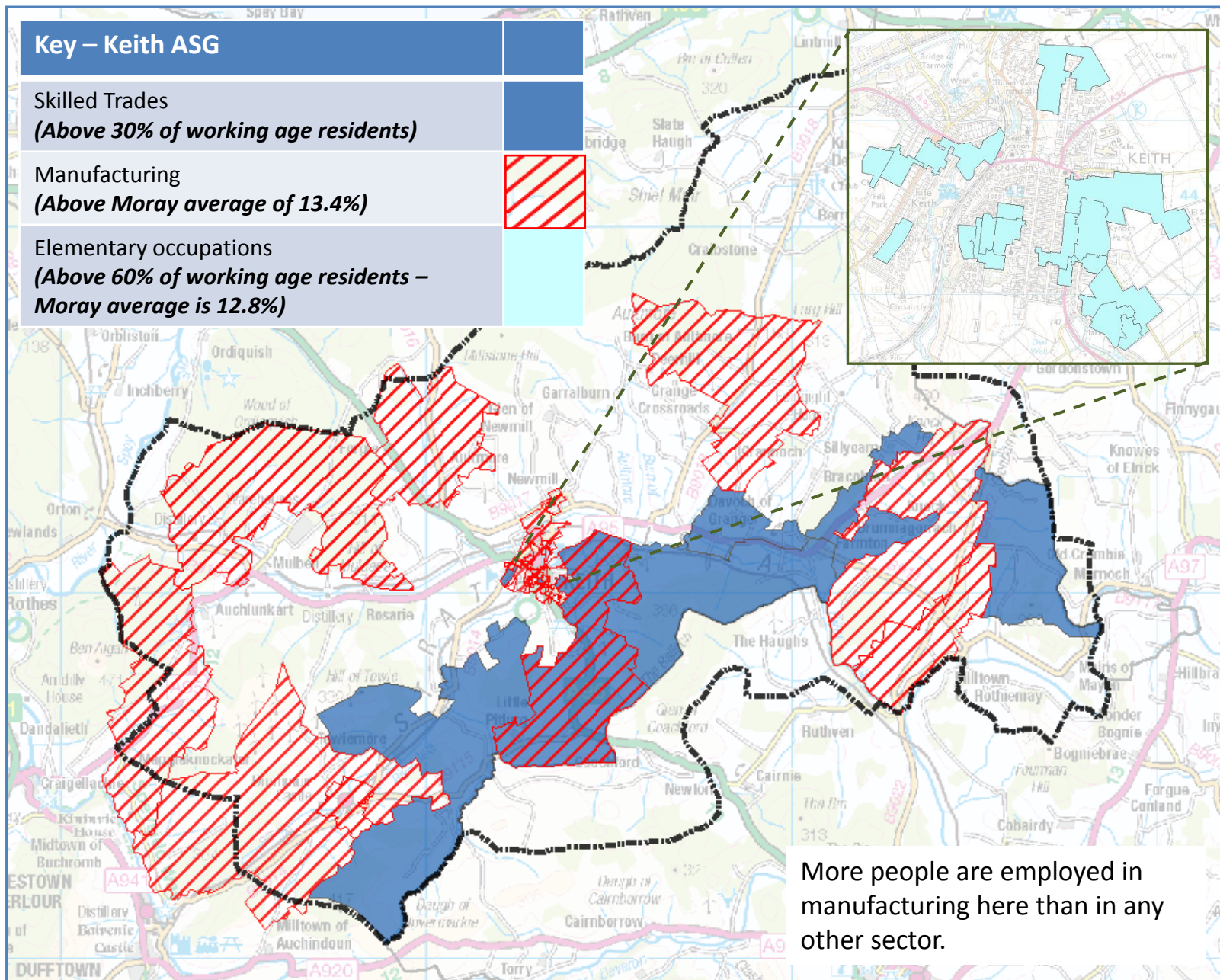


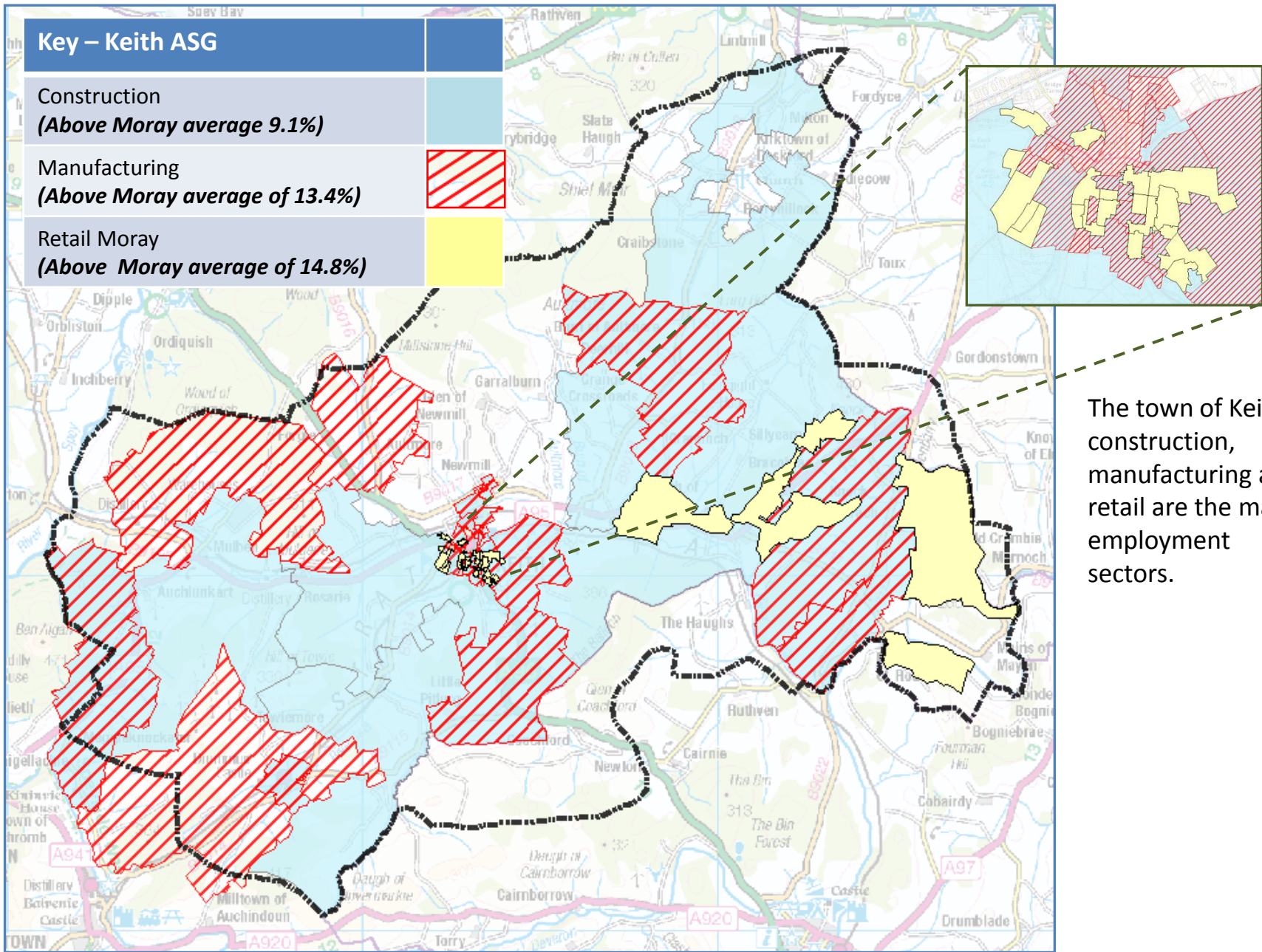
Due to the rural nature of the area as a whole, there is a greater need for private transport: more households in Grange and Rothiemay own two cars or vans than anywhere else in Moray, and the Botriphnie and Newmill area has the most households with three or more cars or vans.

Significantly, there are more households in the town of Keith have no car/van when compared to the rest of Moray.

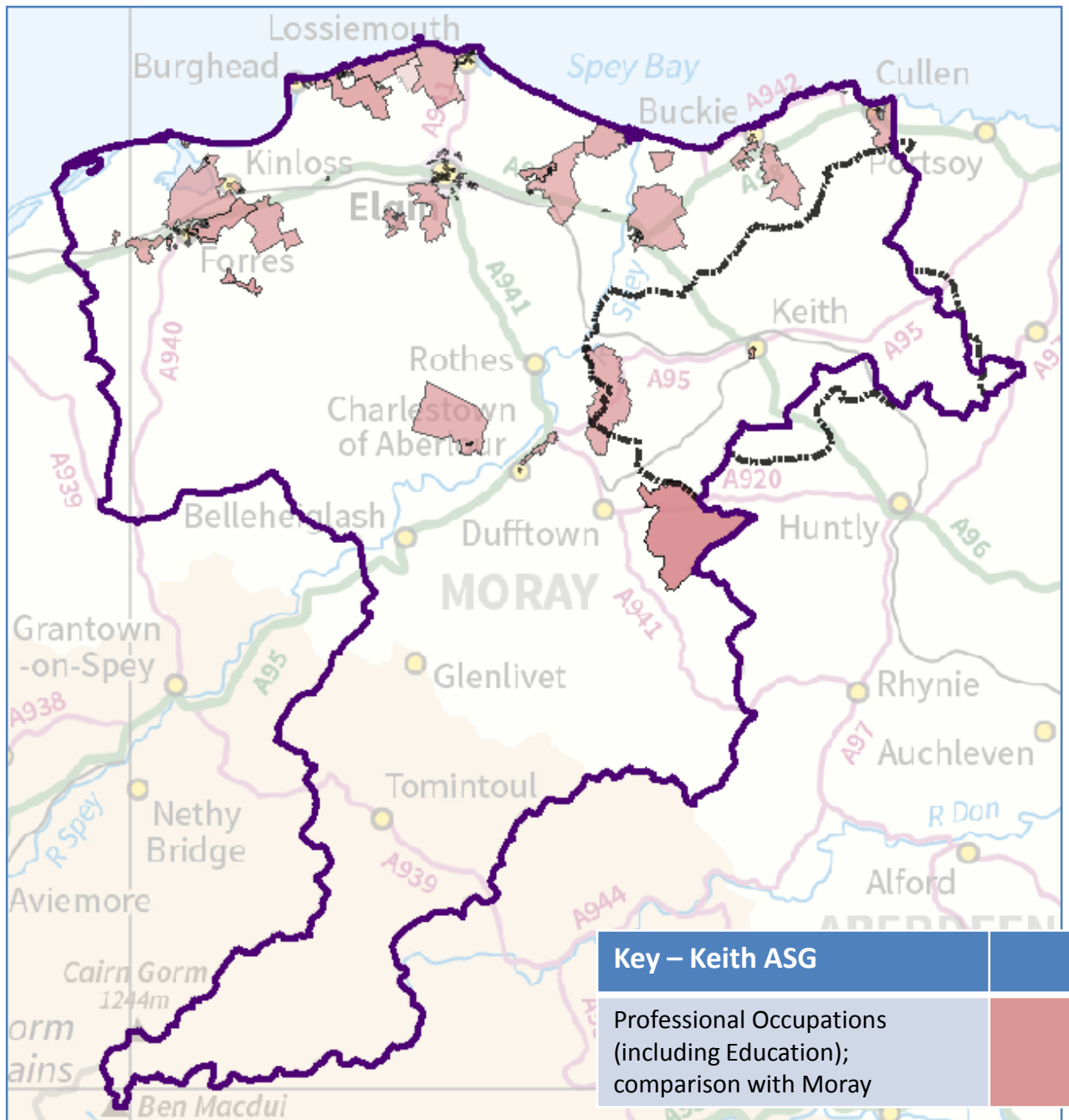

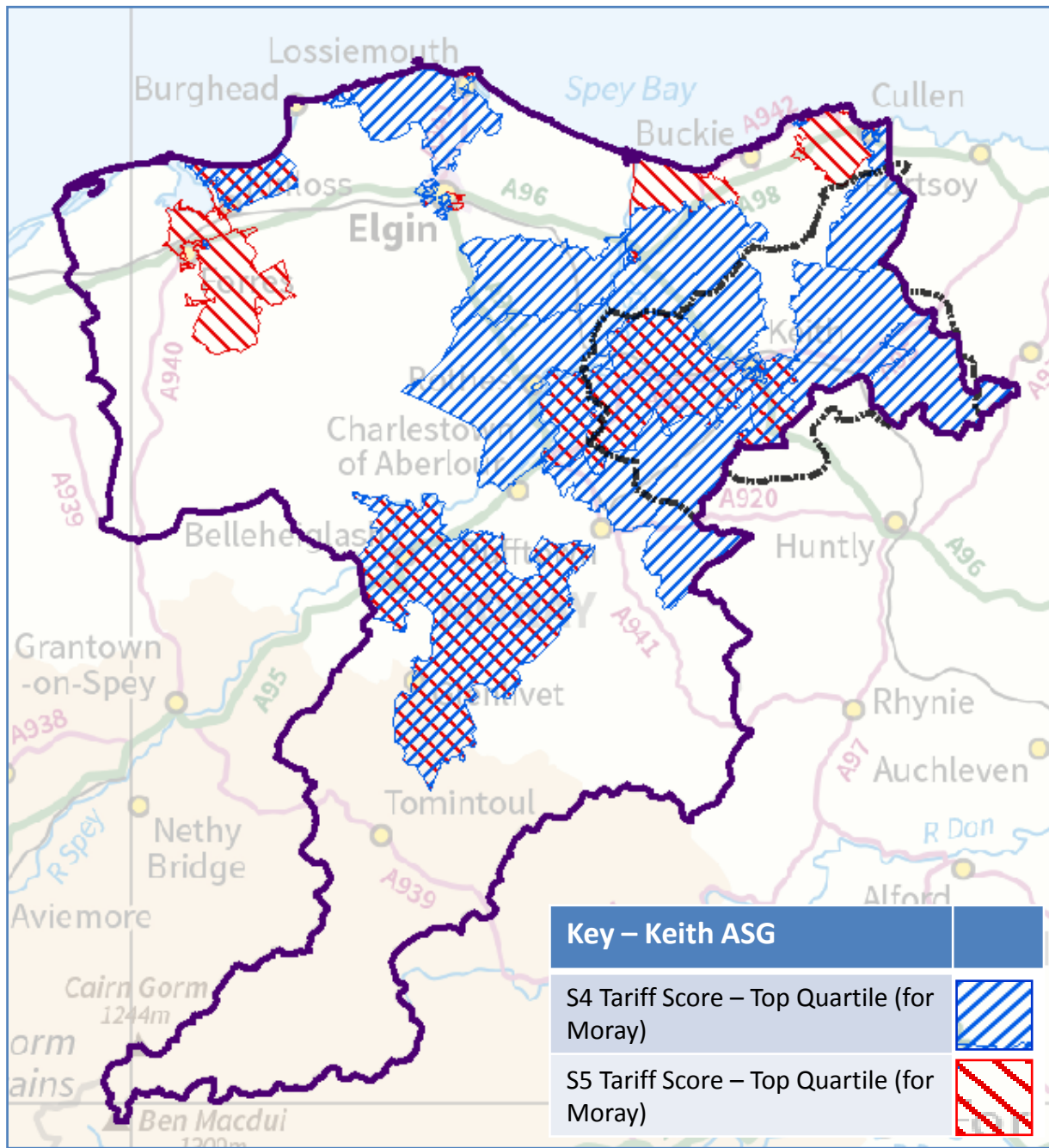


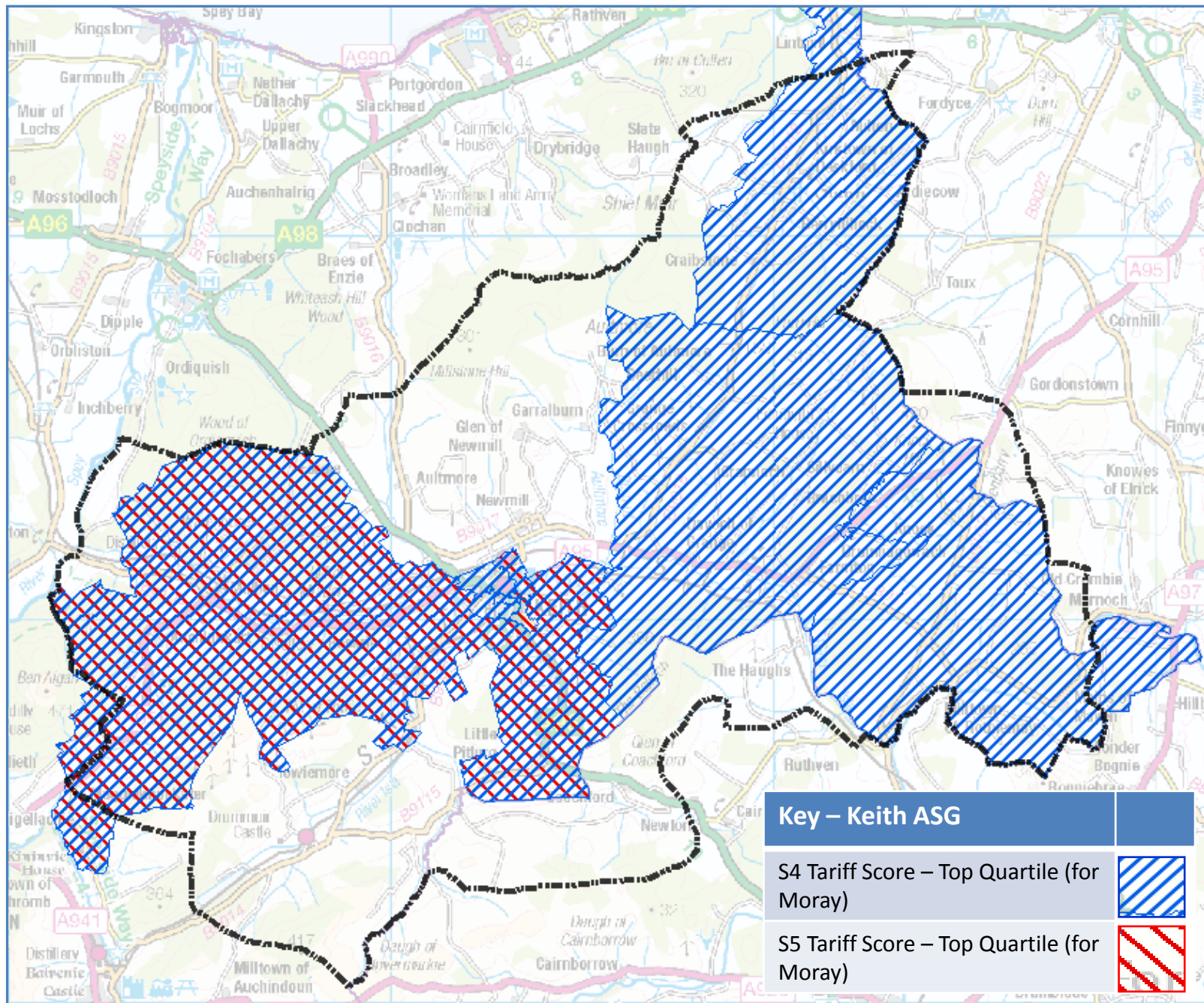


The town of Keith, construction, manufacturing and retail are the main employment sectors.

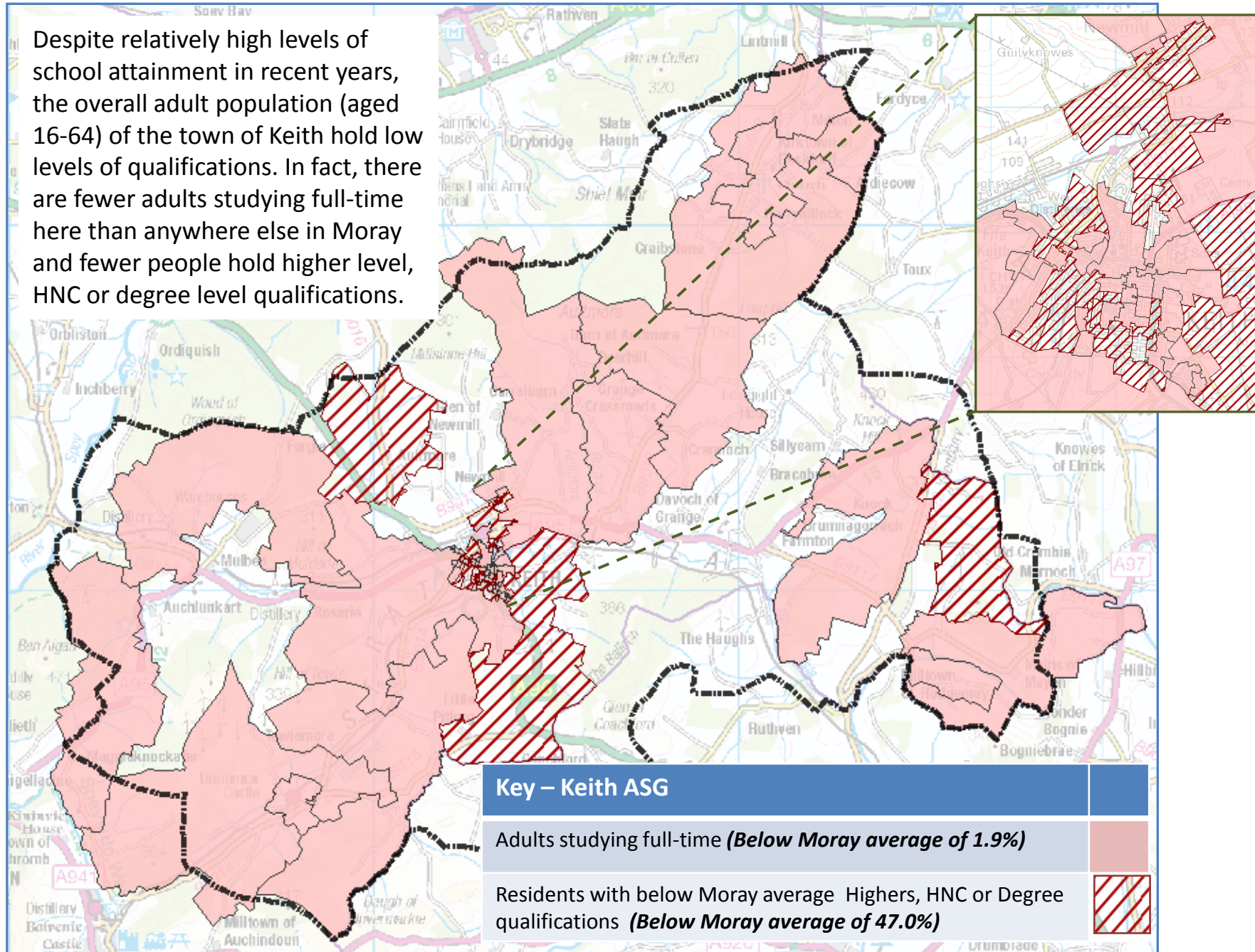


KEITH – EDUCATION



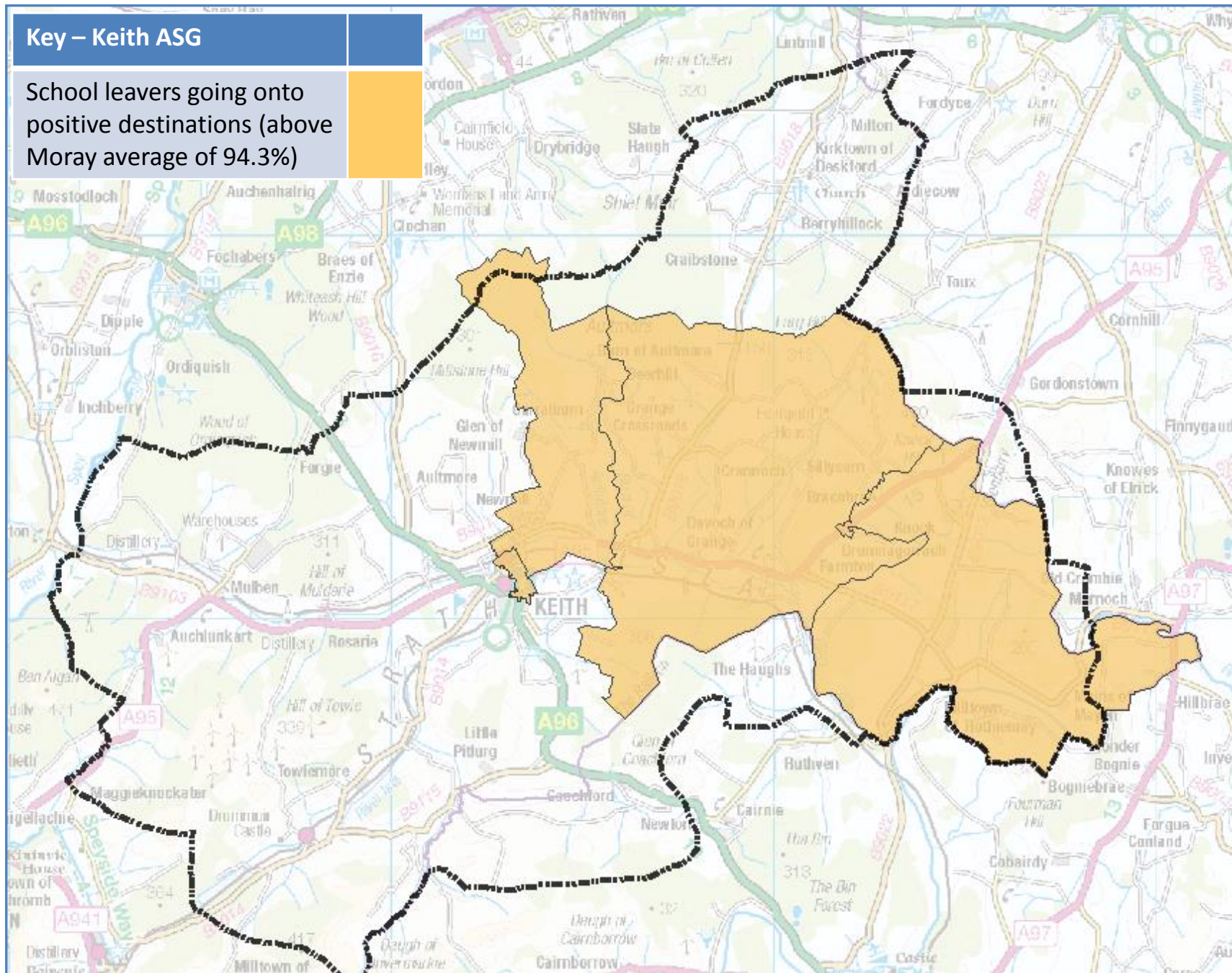


Despite relatively high levels of school attainment in recent years, the overall adult population (aged 16-64) of the town of Keith hold low levels of qualifications. 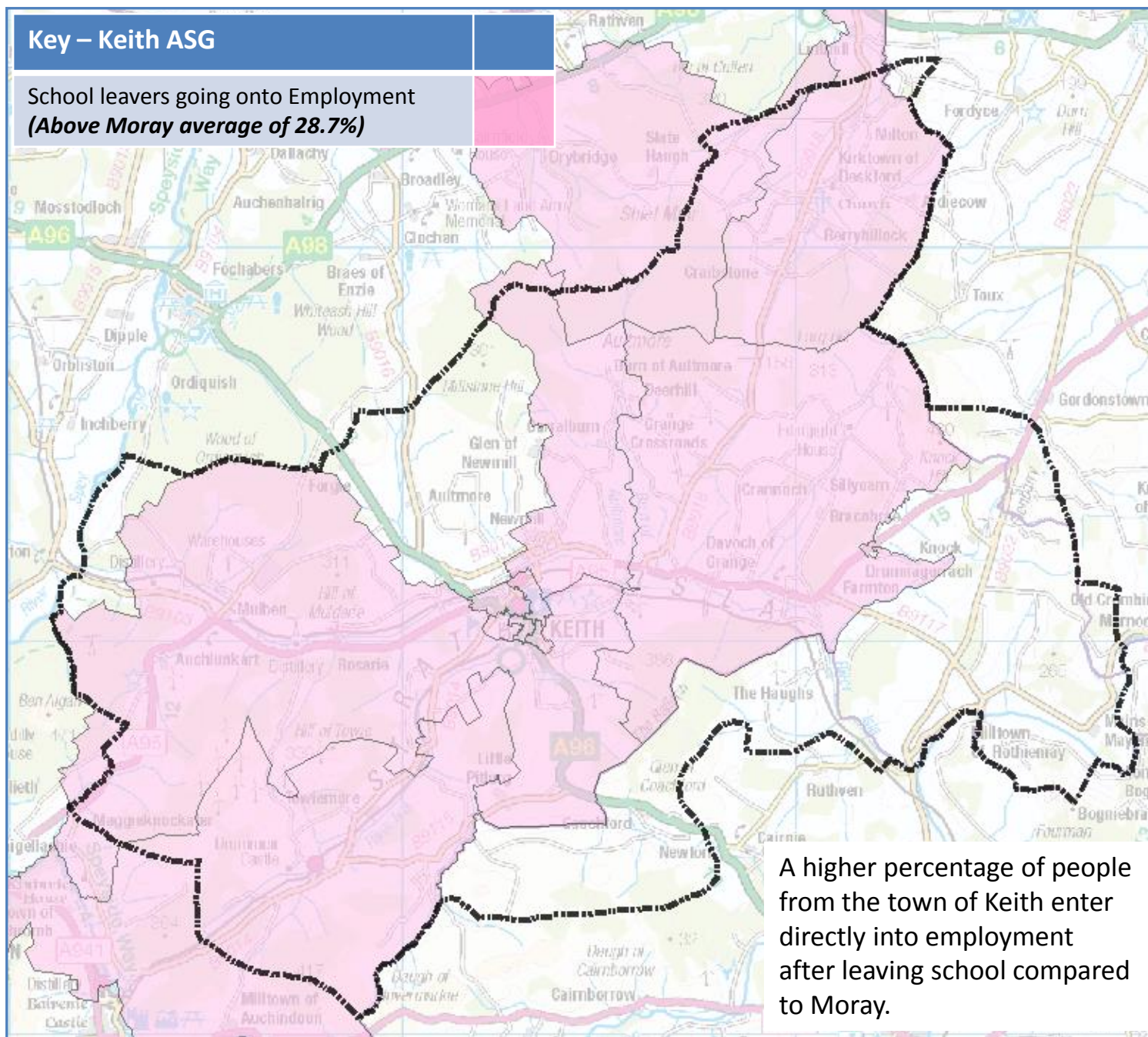

School leavers going onto positive destinations (above Moray average of 94.3%)

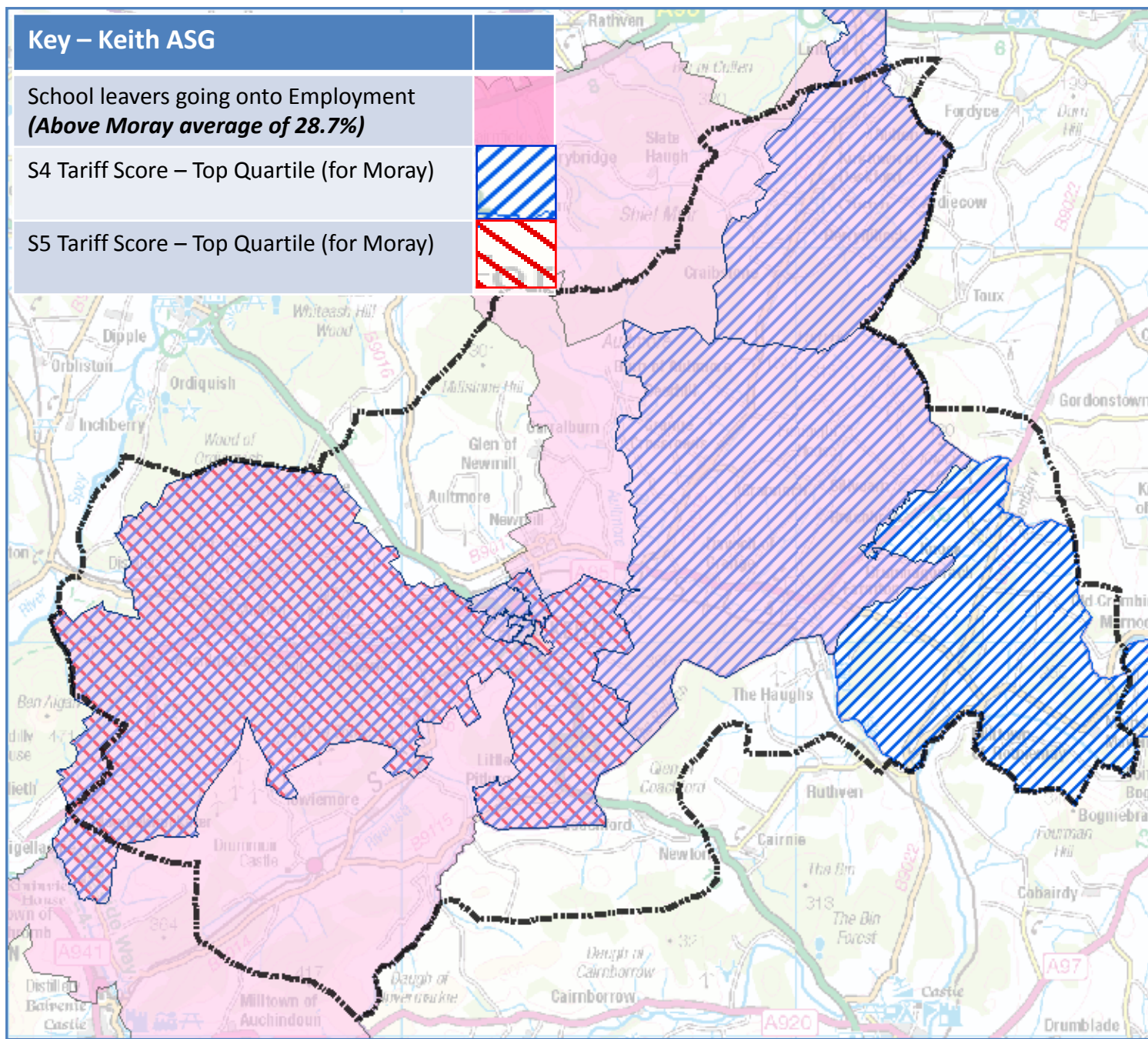

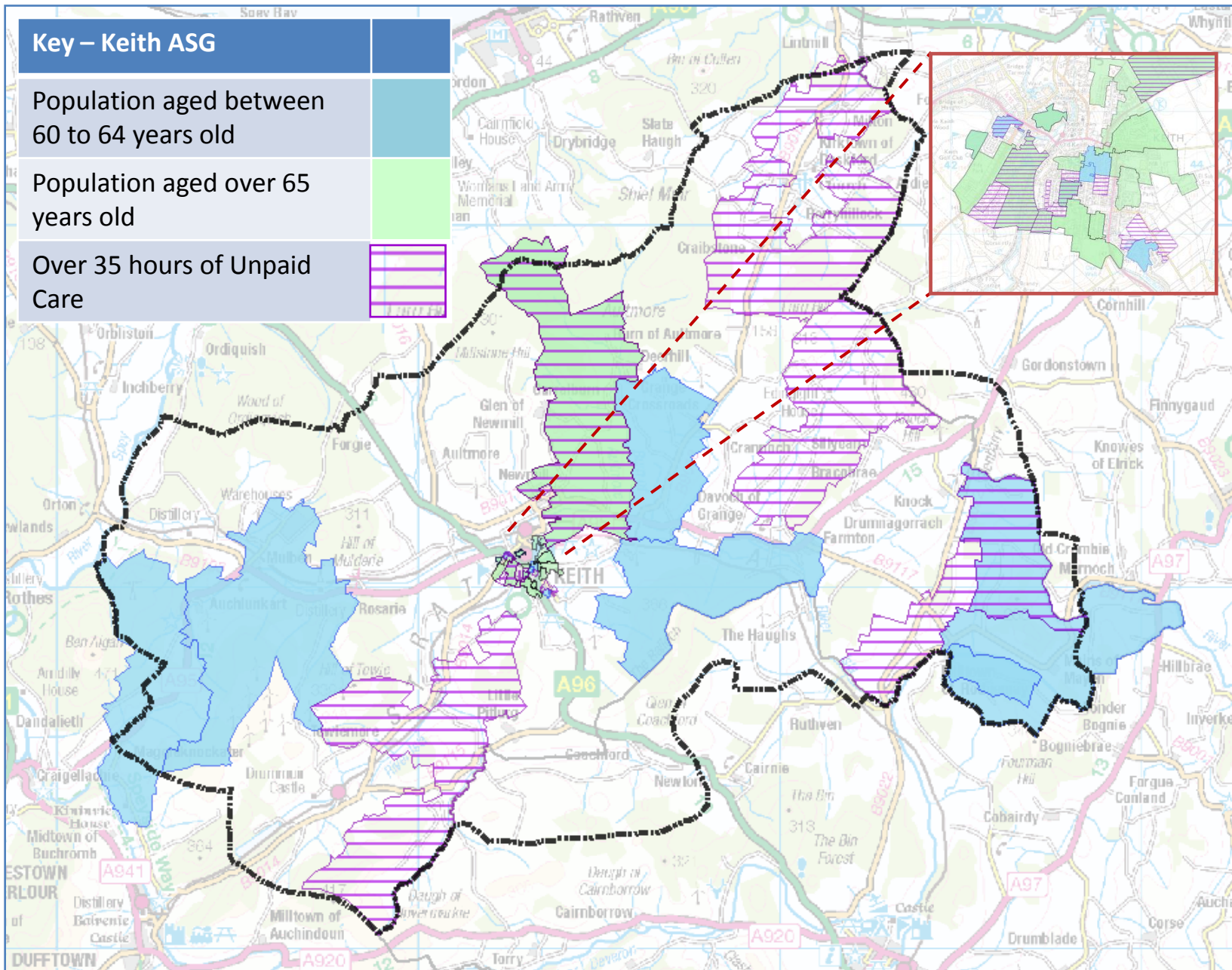
School leavers going onto Employment
(Above Moray average of 28.7%)

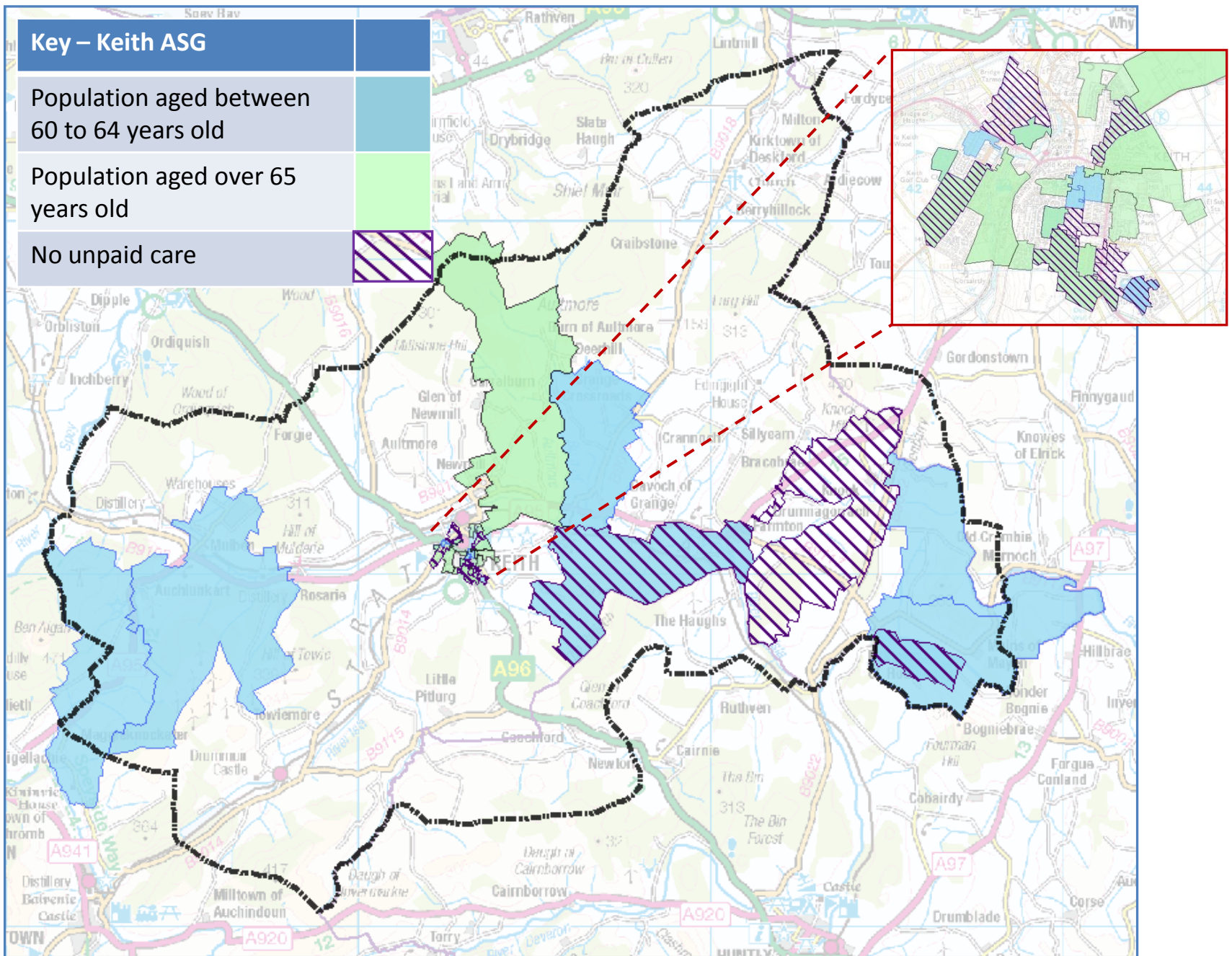


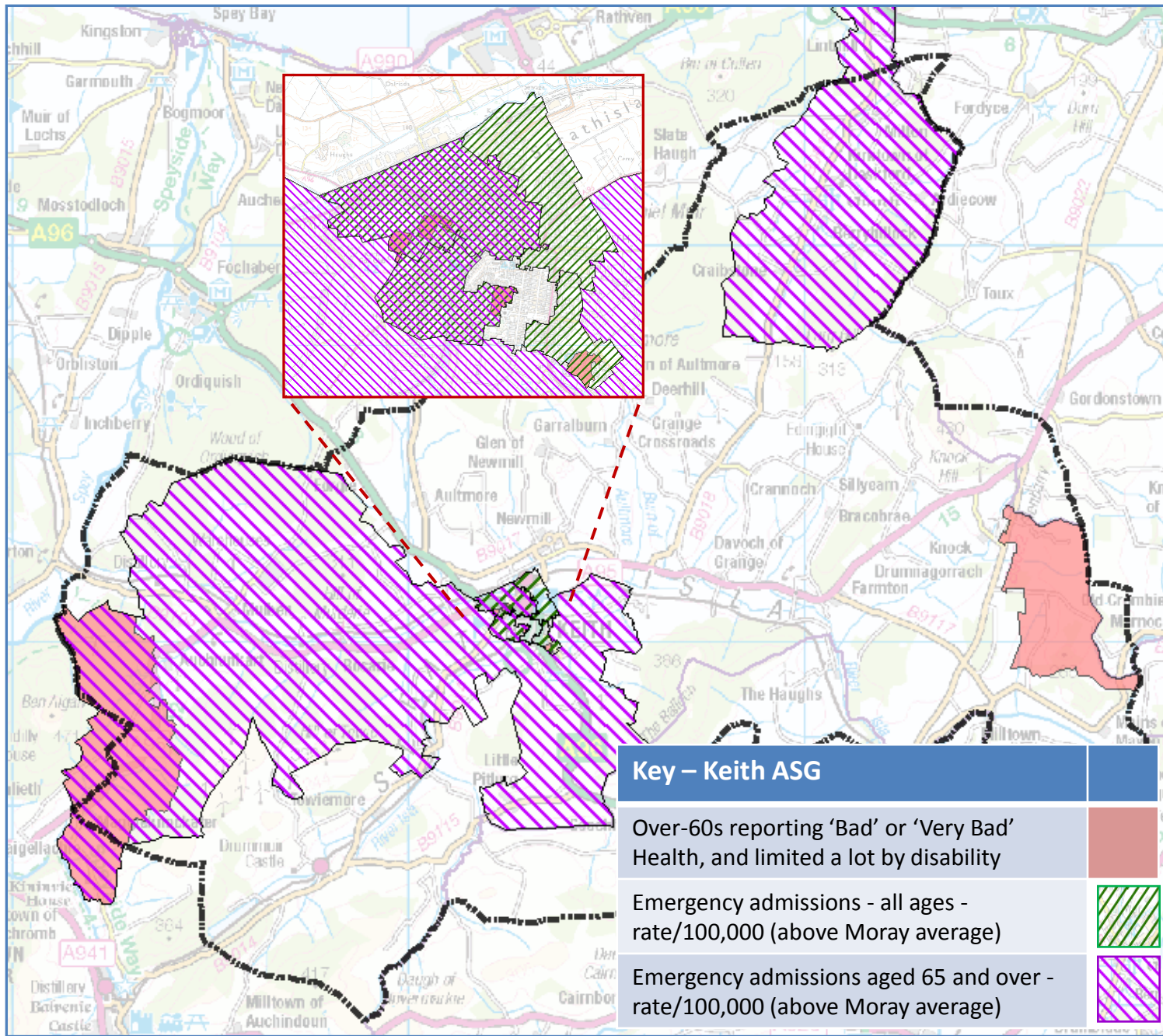
A higher percentage of people from the town of Keith enter directly into employment after leaving school compared to Moray.

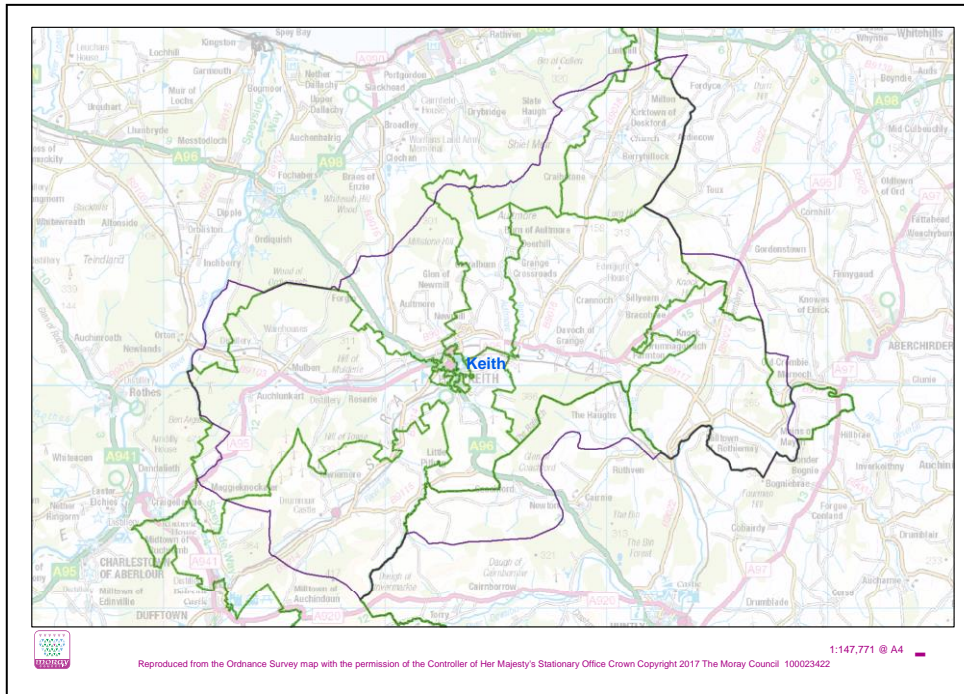

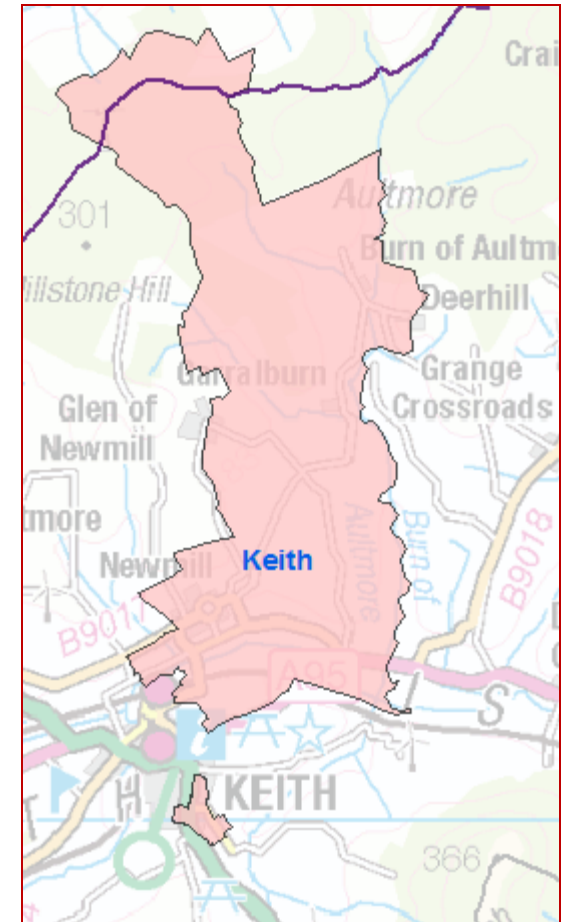
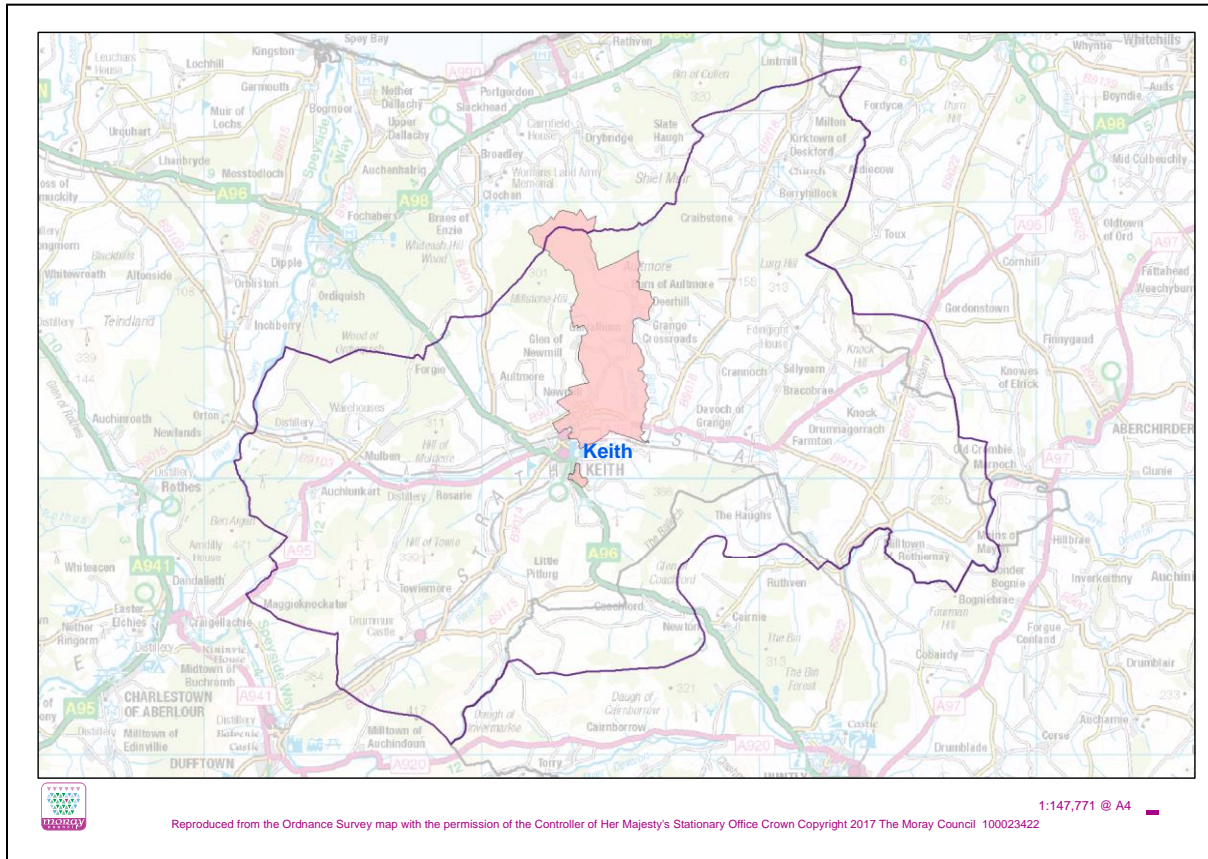




Data-zones in 1st and 2nd most deprived quintiles

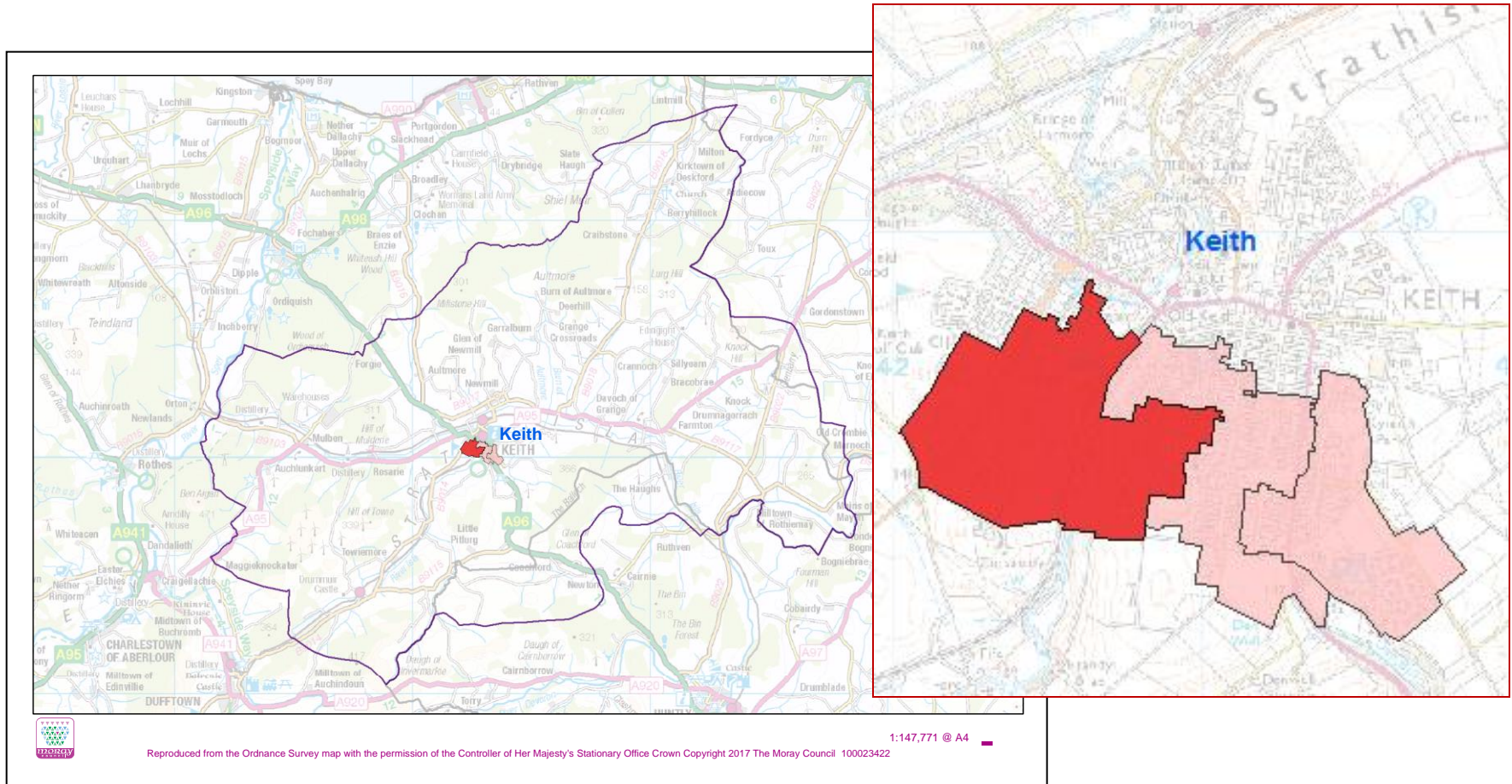
Keith – SIMD Quintiles 1 and 2 - Housing

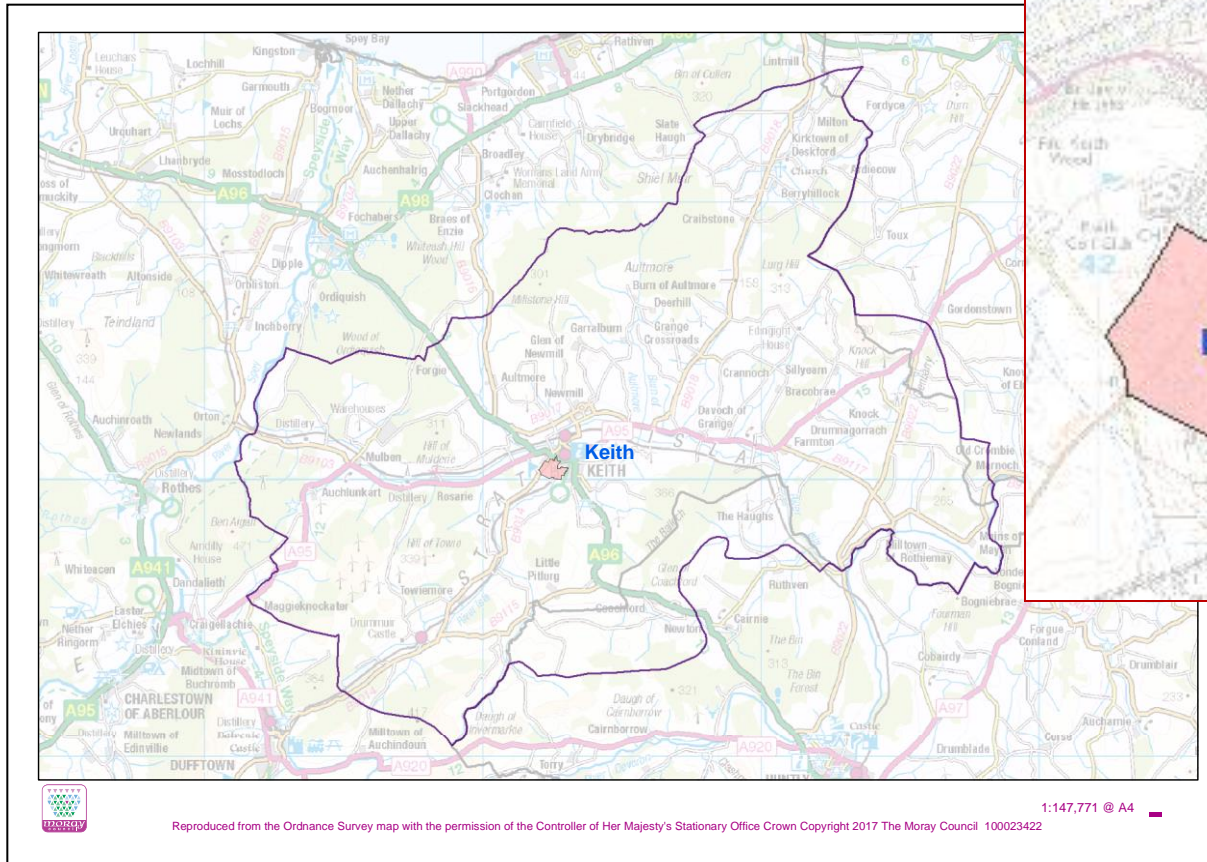

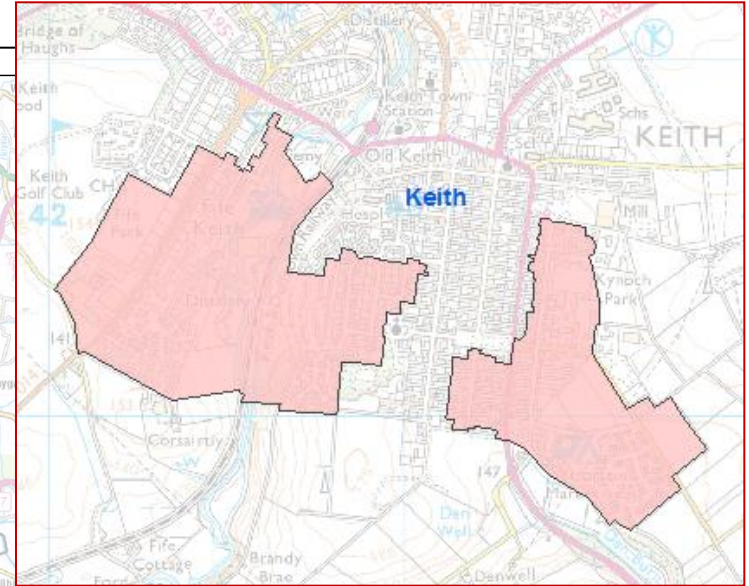

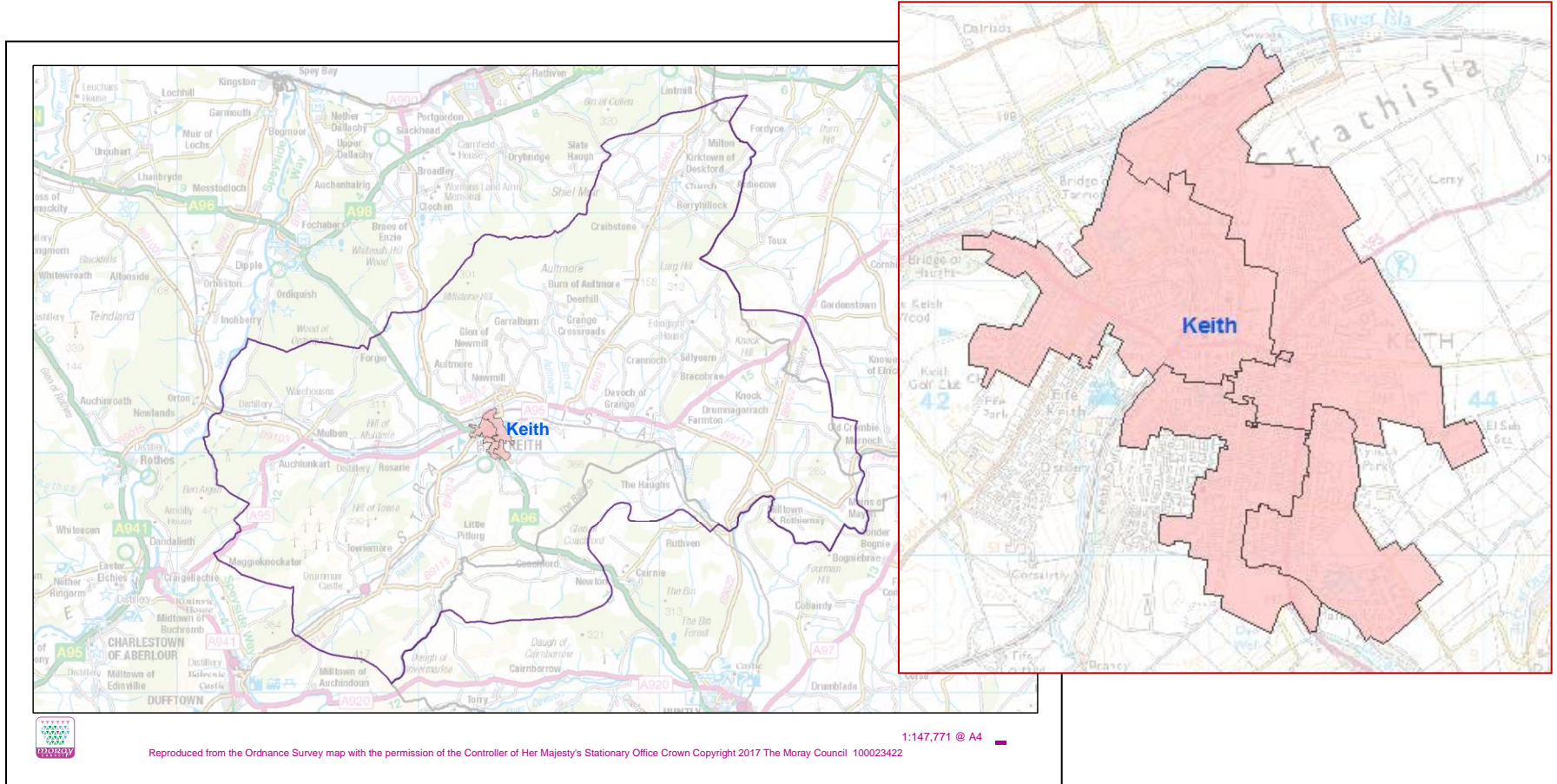

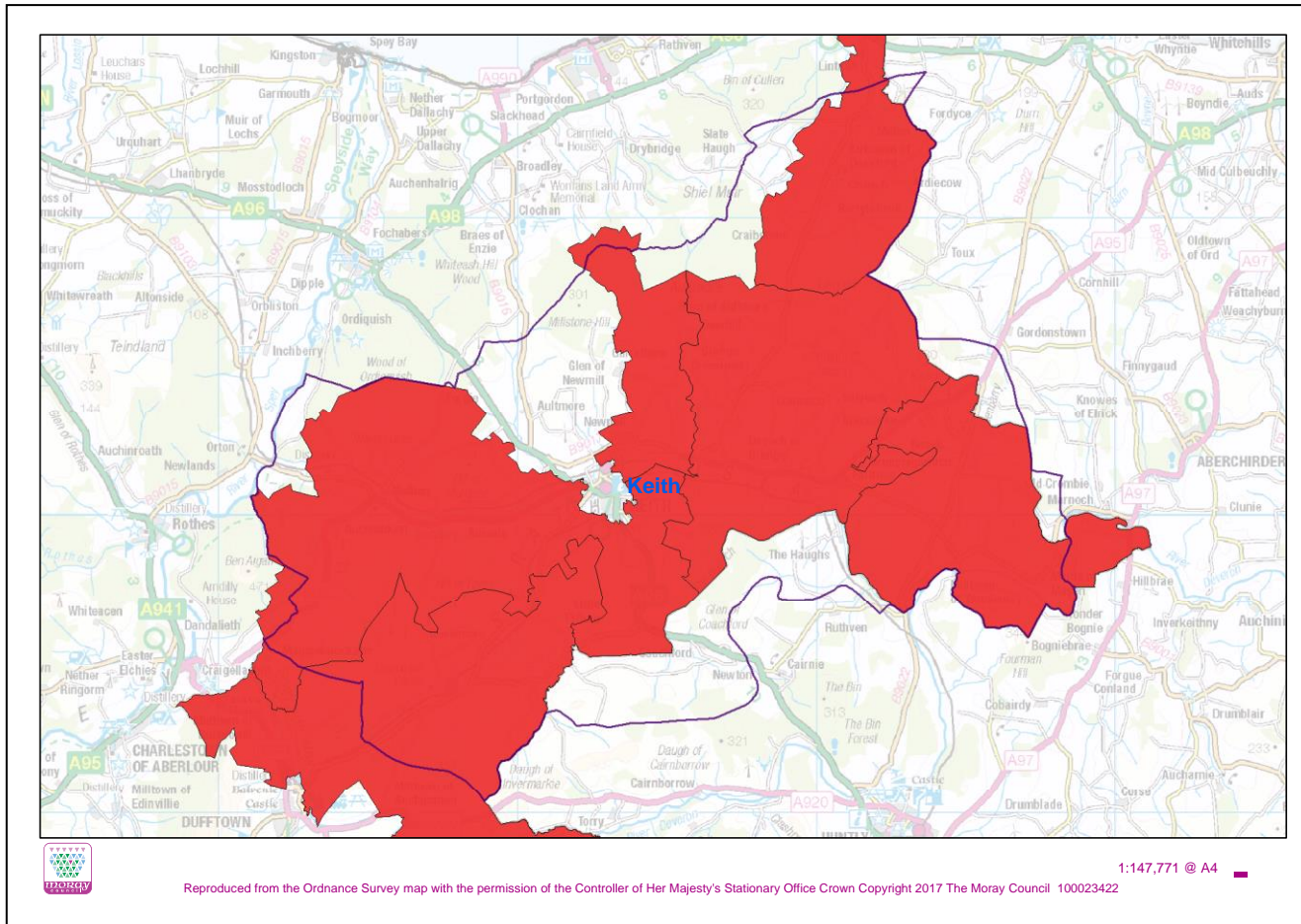
