It was agreed that this will go ahead at a cost of £350 for the initial set-up and first year's maintenance, and £75 per year thereafter. There is a Charrette Mainstreaming Programme Fund 2015-16 which aims to support communities to input directly into the design and development of plans for the future of their areas; the Regen group will look in to this. The Harbour Advisory Committee is dealing with the dredger which should be operational by March 2016.
